FEATURED SOLOIST - Jeffrey L. Stock, Jr. (JR)

JR is a native of Columbia, SC and a 1997 graduate of Irmo High School. He has a B.S. from the University of North Texas in Music Education where he studied Euphonium under Dr. Brian Bowman and a MBA from the University of South Carolina where he concentrated in International Finance. JR taught high school band in the Dallas suburbs between 2002 and 2004 and currently is Portfolio Manager for Tenet Wealth Management, an investment management company he helped form in 2011. In the music arena JR has been 1st chair National Honor Band, MTNA National Brass Soloist Winner, a two-time finalist for the Leonard Falcone Euphonium Competition, a finalist for the ITEA Euphonium Competition and a winner of the Kingsville Concerto Competition. He has been a featured soloist at the Midwest Convention, with the Georgia Brass Band, the Duquesne Brass Band and various schools throughout Texas. In the Finance arena JR is a Chartered Financial Analyst, one of only 146 Charterholders (active and retired) in South Carolina.
