*Maria has been playing horn for nine years under the instruction of Ken Turner and is the principal horn of the South Carolina Philharmonic Youth Orchestra and the Midlands Home School Band. She has attended workshops across the country, including the Kendall Betts Horn Camp, the South East Horn Workshop and the Carolina Summer Music Conservatory. Maria has been the principal horn for the South Carolina All-State Orchestra twice and the first chair horn of the S.C. All-State Band for seven consecutive years. She was a winner of the 2011 Sousa Foundation National Young Artists Solo Competition, the 2012 S.C. Philharmonic Youth Orchestra's Young Artists Concerto Competition, and the 2013 SCBDA Master Recital, and one of three finalists in the 2012 U.S. Army Field Band's All-American Young Artist Competition. Recent performances include the Brahms Trio Op. 40 with the Sterling Chamber Players, the Mozart Horn Concerto No. 2 Mvt. 1 with the USC Wind Ensemble, and the Strauss Horn Concerto No.1 Mvt. 1 with the SCP Youth Orchestra. A National Merit Finalist and a Phi Beta Mu Music Scholarship recipient, Maria plans to pursue a Bachelor of Music in horn performance after her graduation.*
